

INVISIBLE DROP OF ONE CARD

Trick 2 - November, 2005

I had the opportunity to travel all around my native country, Colombia, doing magic shows in amazing places. One day while walking down a pretty street in Manizales - *an area known for sugar cane, coffee and beautiful women* - I figured out a solution to a magic problem, the double lift. I wanted to change the card that I showed, but without leaving the two cards on the deck like a normal double lift and also without the spectator seeing both cards, of course. So I wanted to drop the card that I showed, in the deck, and hold just the second card in my hand. Strange? Yes! It is very strange. But with magic, nothing is impossible. Then I tried different options and found a solution that I have been working on ever since. Now I can I share it with you!

The spectator takes one card and shows it to the audience. Then he puts this card back on the deck. You can control the card and take it to the top of the deck with any technique of your choice. Then make the double lift, showing two cards as one. Leave these cards on the deck out to the right, showing the back of the deck Photo 1.



Now take the cards with your right hand: At the right edge of the card (s), put the right thumb under, and the middle and index fingers on top, holding the cards as one, in double lift. Photo 2.



Now, you need to show this next move naturally. Turn both hands at the same time: the hand that has the card(s) turns palm up and the hand that has the deck turns palm down, Photo 3.



At this moment, without stopping, the right middle finger pushes the card back under the left middle finger. The left middle finger takes the card. Photo number 4 shows the action under the deck, but it is invisible to the audience.

In only one movement, the right hand, with only one card, moves far away from the left hand and leaves the changed card face down on the table. Ready for the great finale. Now with all your attention on the card (it is face down on the table) take the card and move it a little, turn it face up. The card has been changed!
