

Control the spectator's card

Trick 4- January, 2006

We know different ways to control a card. I have an alternative to control a card after the spectator puts it on the deck. Give the deck to the spectator and he will pick any card. Tell him to show it to everybody. At this moment, turn the card at the bottom of the deck face up. Photo no. 1.



Take the deck in your hand in a position shuffle Hindu. Pass a little packet of the cards to your left hand. Tell the spectator to say stop wherever he wants?.



When he says stop, he needs to put the card on the top of the packet in your left hand. Put the whole packet that you have in your right hand on top of the packet that you have in your left hand. Photo no. 2.

Now remind the audience that you don't know which card he took, and that you don't know where his card is in the deck.

Pretend to concentrate on the spectator's card and say that you see something. Now spread the deck in your hand from left to right, and inside the deck will appear a card face up (this is the control card

and the next card, from this card - from right to the left- is t h e spectator's



c a r d) P h o t o n o . 3 .

Open your eyes wide as if you are surprised and point to the card that is face up and say: This is your card! The spectator will say no. Apologize and cut the packet from this card, leaving the face-up card on top of the packet in your left hand.

Now put the packet that you have in your right hand under the packet in your left hand. Now take the face-up card, turn it over and put it in the middle of the deck. At this point, you have the spectator's card on the top of the deck. You can make it appear any way you want, such as a double lift, flying or in your j a c k e t .
